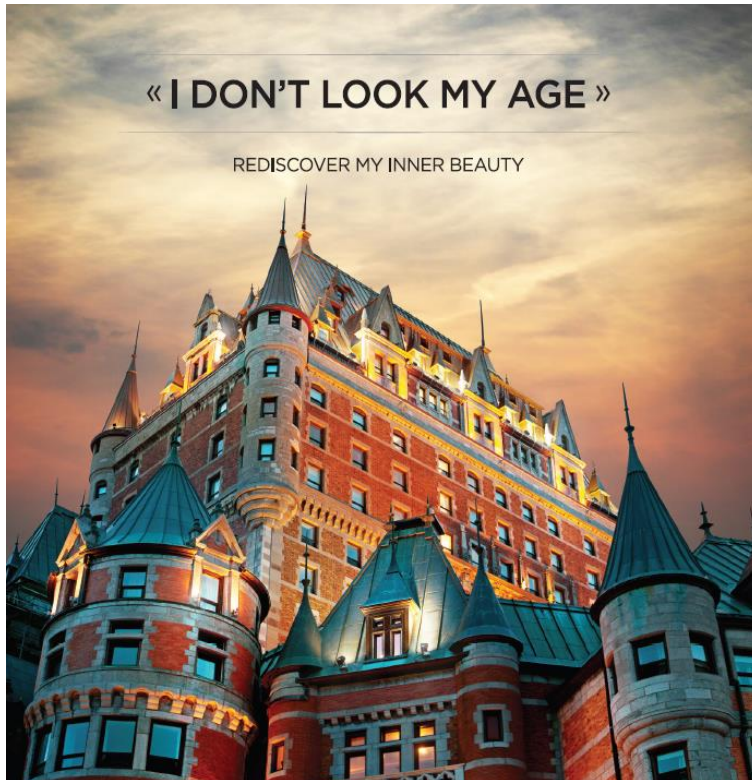


A GRAND MAKEOVER



Fairmont Le Château Frontenac has just completed a 70 million \$ revitalization and modernization. The renovation of Quebec City's landmark hotel will strengthen its positioning amongst the best hotels in the world. The revitalization and transformation of the Château Frontenac includes the renovation of guestrooms, renovation and expansion of the Fairmont Gold floors, transformation of the main lobby, expansion of the banquet areas, introduction of new restaurant concepts and addition of an urban Spa. Renovations were completed in June 2014.

Internationally acclaimed design firms Wilson Associates and Rockwell Group were selected to lead this grand project. Wilson, whose past design projects have included The Fairmont Monte Carlo, The Langham Hong Kong and Four Seasons Hotel Sydney is

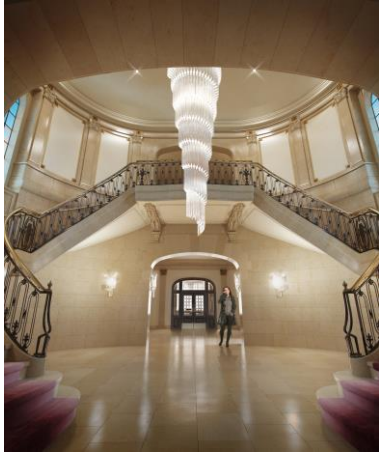
overseeing the guestroom, corridors and banquet/meeting areas. Rockwell, whose past design projects have included the W Paris-Opéra, The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas and Ames Hotel Boston is overseeing the main lobby and restaurant projects.

HERITAGE AND CONTEMPORARY BLEND AS PART OF THE RENOVATION PROJECT

At the forefront of the renovation project was the wish to preserve and renovate this icon of Quebec's heritage and ensure its continuity while adding a contemporary dimension that will enable it to meet the highest expectations. It marks a transition to a contemporary style that remains respectful of the hotel's history. As such, existing historic details and materials have been preserved throughout this project and the introduction of new design styles is respectful of the hotel's history.

The history of the hotel and its site, which boasts over 400 years, is showcased through heritage elements and meticulous positioning of historical 400 year old artefacts within specially designed windows. Fairmont Le Château Frontenac sits on the site of the Saint-Louis Forts and Châteaux where for more than 200 years, were the site of the official residence and seat of power of the French and British governors.

OVERVIEW OF PROJECTS



Renovation of the main lobby has brought majestic elements and incorporated signature pieces to the existing historic details which have been preserved.

All of the hotel's 611 guestrooms have been renovated.

354 guestrooms introduce a more contemporary design and style while 257 guestrooms offer a classic Château style.



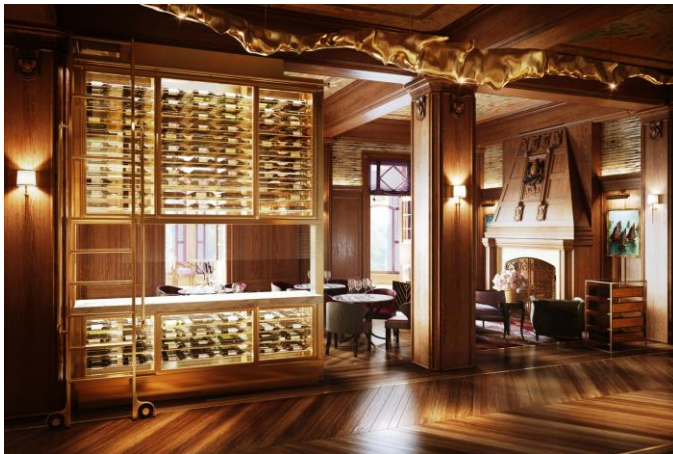
Fairmont Gold, Château Frontenac's boutique hotel has increased its guestrooms from 46 to 60 while its lounge size has also increased. The exclusive services of Fairmont Gold include a private lounge to relax, a dedicated Concierge, deluxe continental breakfast and hors d'oeuvres in the lounge. Fairmont Gold guestrooms are located in the higher floors of the main tower, offering the best views of the city and river.





NEW EXECUTIVE CHEF OVERSEES THE HOTEL'S GRAND FOOD & BEVERAGE TRANSFORMATION

Appointed in 2013, Executive Chef Baptiste Peupion is originally from Paris and cumulates more than 15 years in the culinary world. Baptiste worked many years for world renowned Chef Alain Ducasse, becoming the youngest Chef to head one of his restaurants (Rech, Paris in 2007 and 2008), when he was only 29 year old. Just before joining the Château, he was Chef de Cuisine at the Shangri-La Hotel in Paris. His international career has led him to travel to several countries including the UK, the United States, Australia, Hong Kong and France. Throughout his career, he worked in several famous Michelin-starred restaurants including Louis XV at Hotel de Paris, Monaco (3 stars) and Hotel de Crillon in Paris (2 stars).

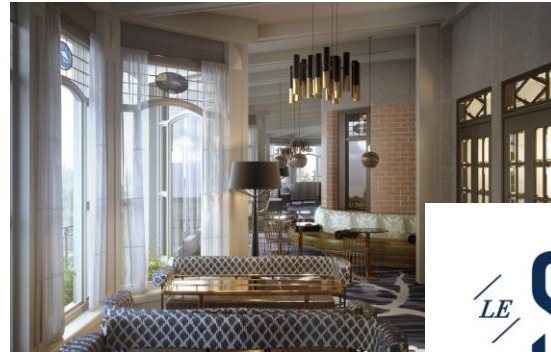
